



Leaving a gift in your Will to The Children's Hospital at Westmead

We recommend that you discuss the type of gift you intend to make to the Hospital with your family and solicitor prior to finalising your Will.

Types of gifts

- Residual – is the remainder of your estate after considering your loved ones and expenses have been deducted.
- Pecuniary – is a gift of a specific amount, such as \$10,000.
- Asset or assets – can be property or shares.

Wording suggestions

It is important that your bequest gift is worded correctly, and the following is recommended as a guide. You may give this wording to your solicitor who is preparing your Will.

“I give to **Sydney Children's Hospitals Foundation, ABN 72 003 073 185**, being for **The Children's Hospital at Westmead**,

- The residue of my estate (or __% of the residue of my estate),
- or , the whole of my estate (or __% of my estate),
- the sum of \$___,
- Asset or assets,

for which the receipt of the Treasurer or other authorised officer shall be an absolute discharge.”
